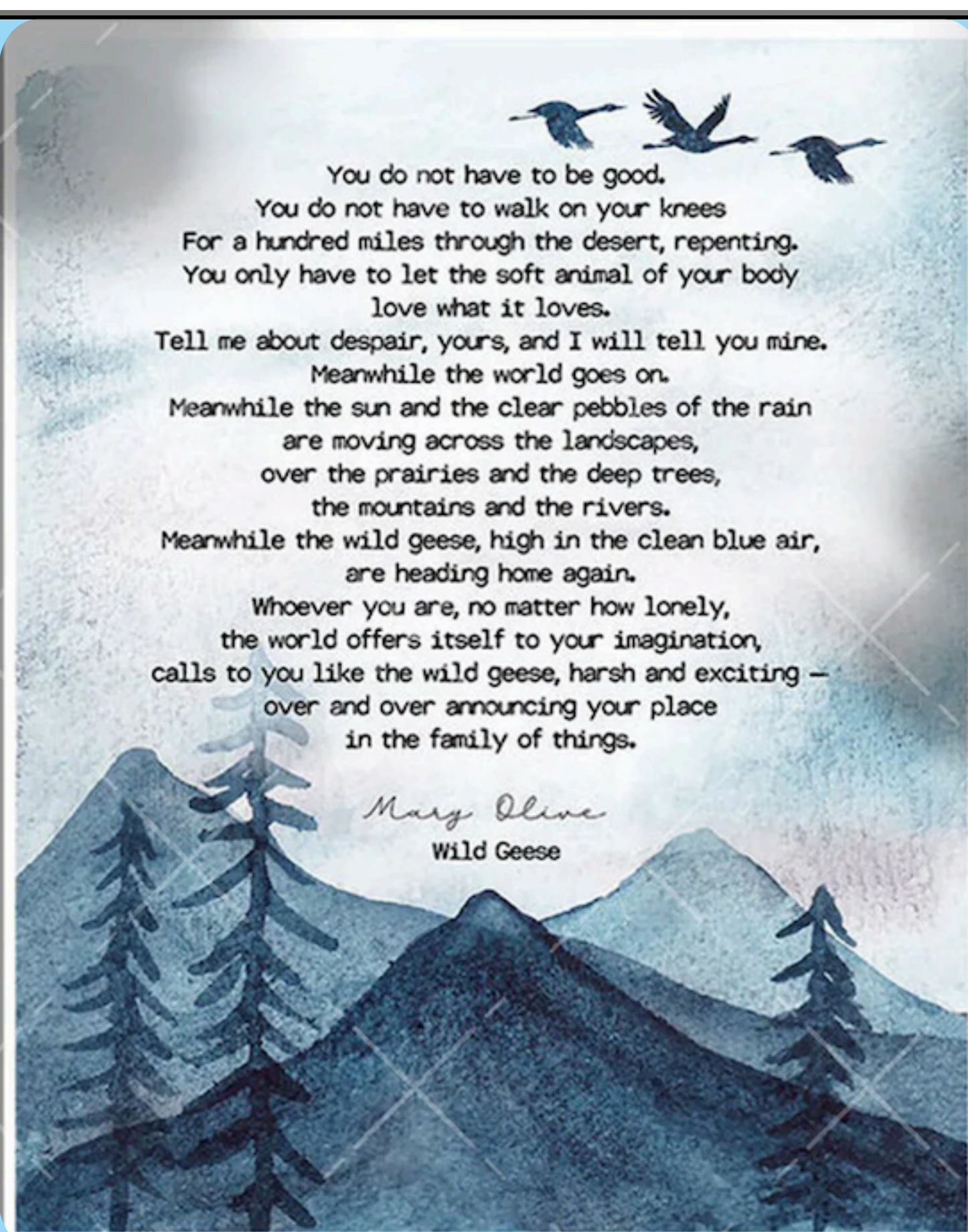

No appointment is necessary. Just drop off your knives, browse the store or grab some lunch and pick up your knives when they are ready.

Spijk uses a traditional Japanese whetstone method to ensure you leave with the sharpest knives in town!

Prices are as follows-
\$2.00 per blade inch
\$3.00 per serrated blade inch
\$3.00 for minor blade repair (chips etc)
\$8.00 for major blade repair (large chips etc)
\$12.00 for tip repair/edge restoration
